OUR TRAINING SESSIONS

Harmoneyes offer two different deaf awareness courses, one fun session and one in depth course. Both courses are taught by experienced tutors who are Disclosure & Baring Service checked.

The prices quoted for the deaf awareness course is for between up to 20 students (courses can go ahead with a minimum of 10 students) per course and include all handouts.
